All Boats entered in this Competition must depart over Whakatane Bar and return to Whakatane.

All fish weighed must have been caught from a Surtees boat.

One fish to be weighed only, per angler, per species, per day.

VENUE

Whakatane Sport Fishing Clubrooms situated on the main wharf, Muriwai Drive, Whakatane.

REGISTRATION

Early entries registered and paid before 1st April go into a lucky prize draw. Late entries will be taken at the Whakatane Sport Fishing Clubrooms from 5pm on Friday, 15th April 2016.

BRIEFING

Will be held in the Whakatane Sport Fishing Clubrooms at 7.30pm on Friday, 15th April 2016.

Surtees tee shirts (from entry pack) must be worn by competitors to be eligible for spot prizes.

All Skippers or a nominated crew member **MUST** attend the briefing. Late entries will be accepted at the briefing but no later than 7.30pm.

Snapper: 35cm Tarakihi: 25cm Kingfish: 100cm Trevally: 25cm

Kahawai: No size limit applies

WEIGHING OF FISH

Fish will be weighed at the Whakatane Sport Fishing Club's Weigh Station situated beside the Boat Ramp on the Whakatane River.

The weigh station will be open:

Saturday, 16th April 3.00pm - 6.00pm 2.00pm - 3.00pm Sunday, 17th April

In the event of 2 or more fish being equal in weight the first fish weighed will be deemed the winner.



SAFETY RULES

- All skippers or a nominated crew member must attend a briefing.
 The principal briefing for the Surtees Eleventh Annual Fishing
 Competition will be held on Friday 15th April 2016 at 7.30pm in
 the Whakatane Sport Fishing clubrooms. Attendance to this
 briefing is compulsory and no team can compete in this
 Competition until the skipper has attended a briefing.
- 2. It shall be the responsibility of the skipper or a nominated crew member to advise his/her other team members of the information given at the briefing.
- 3. In the interest of safety the Competition Committee reserves the right to alter all times for the duration of the Competition depending on the weather or sea conditions.
- 4. In the event of an emergency on the water, participants are to notify the Whakatane Coastguard on VHF channel 80.
- 5. All boats must carry correct size Life Jackets for all passengers. It is advised all participants wear Life Jackets while crossing the Whakatane River Bar.
- 6. All participants agree and accept:-
- 7. To enter this Competition at their own risk.
- 8. That boating and fishing involves a risk.
- 9. Not to hold Competition organisers, Officials, Sponsors or any other person involved with the Competition liable for any loss or injury to person or equipment incurred during the Competition.
- 10. Notwithstanding any representations made, it shall be the responsibility of all participants to ensure that the provisions of all statutes, ordinances, regulations and by-laws related to (but not limited) to boating and fishing are complied with.
- 11. All participants agree to have read and understood the Competition Rules.

SKIPPER RESPONSIBILITY

- I have the necessary skill, knowledge and qualifications to safeguard all on board.
- My Surtees and all equipment are properly maintained.
- My Surtees carries all the necessary safety equipment.
- We have a minimum of two means of communication;
 i.e. VHF marine radio, cell phone, flares.
- Each passenger has a correctly fitting buoyancy aid.
- My passengers are briefed on the location and use of all safety equipment.
- My vessel is loaded within its limit and all equipment is securely stowed.
